Rates

Lessons are held in term blocks (10 weeks) which correspond to the term calendar in STATE schools.

Time slots are available in 30-minute and 60-minute lessons. Lesson prices are as follows: \$45 – per 30-minute lesson & \$80 – per 60-minute lesson.

Students are required to commit to the term to secure their time slot

Payments are to be made via banking transfer in full at beginning of each term and are non-refundable

An invoice will be sent to you via email before the start of term. Payment for a full term is required prior to commence of tuition otherwise lessons can be withheld until received.

<u>Lessons</u>

Drum kits (both electronic and acoustic sets) are provided, however students must provide their own drumsticks.

Sheet music handouts are given to each student for practice. Students will need a folder to keep their material in and bring to each lesson.

Occasionally some material may be under copyright. You will be advised when method books and sheet music are required for purchase for a 3rd party.

The Teacher is fully insured for public liability and carries the Working With Children Blue Card.

It is important to note that while a Teacher will endeavour to ensure that all Pupils make satisfactory progress, this cannot be guaranteed. In particular, careful regular practice as advised by the Teacher is a prerequisite of success on a musical instrument.

Attendance

Students are expected to arrive on time and have their drumsticks and folder at each lesson.

If you are running late for any reason, please call or text me as soon as possible. Your lesson time will not be extended because you are late, and you will still be charged the full amount for that lesson.

If I am running late for any reason, I will notify you as soon as possible and make up the full lesson time for you.

If you have to miss a lesson for any reason, you are required to notify me at least 24 hours in advance of your scheduled lesson time. Failure to do so will still incur the lesson fee.

Missed lessons will be rescheduled in the 2-week holiday between terms unless it is possible to do so earlier.

If I have to miss a lesson for any reason, I will notify you as soon as I know of the conflict. I will schedule a make-up lesson if this occurs.

If you are ill or recovering from an illness, please let me know as soon as possible and we will arrange a makeup lesson. I would rather all parties involved be healthy than risk exposing more people to that illness.

If school is cancelled for teacher only day, public holidays or any other reason, please let me know if you will be attending your lesson. In most cases, I will still be teaching on days when school has been cancelled. Without prior notice, I will expect you at your lesson time.

In the event of further COVID restrictions teaching will move to online lessons via a streaming platform such as zoom.

Practise Expectations

Expectations for at-home practice durations scale according to weekly lesson durations.

Students taking 30-minute lessons should practice 30 minutes/day, 4-5 days/week.

Students taking 60-minute lessons should practice 60 minutes/day, 5-6 days/week.

These expectations will help the student be as prepared as possible for each individual lesson as progress is made more quickly by those students who maintain the recommended practising time. This also helps with each student's physical and mental stamina, which will make each lesson more productive, thereby increasing the value of each lesson.

Practise sessions should be no longer than 30 minutes in length for younger students. Older students should use breaks during longer practise sessions, usually taking 5 minutes of rest after every 30 minutes of practice. Fatigue and injuries due to overuse can eventually become a concern if the student does not utilise sufficient practise breaks.

Parent Expectations

Once each lesson is completed it is up to the student to do his or her own practising. Parents are encouraged to be involved in their child's practise, as all children/students need help with discipline. It is important to remind and encourage your children to practise, and supervision of

practise is encouraged until a routine is begun. Students and parents both need to be accountable for consistent, quality practise.

Quality practising is without distractions. Practise time should take place in a quiet, well lit, and comfortable area. Practise time should be interruption-free (i.e. no phone calls/texting, no TV, no computer, etc.).
